COFFEE CUP AFGHAN SQUARE

This is an afghan block that I created for my sit 'n' stitch group - Playa Vista Yarn Crafters. We created an afghan for the Vineyard Christian Fellowship's Coffee Connection to raffle off to their patrons and bring some awareness that we meet at the location for any interested new members.

The following chart is based on Red Heart Soft's gauge printed on the label. The contrasting square - crocheted in the same yarn, different color (9344 Chocolate), minus coffee cup - came out to size while I had to decrease my needle size to a 6 for this square.



MATERIALS

- 1 skein Red Heart Soft (1882 Toast)
- Needles: US 8-5.0 mm or size necessary to obtain gauge

GAUGE: 17 stitches x 23 rows = 4 in (10cm) on size US 8-5.0 mm needles

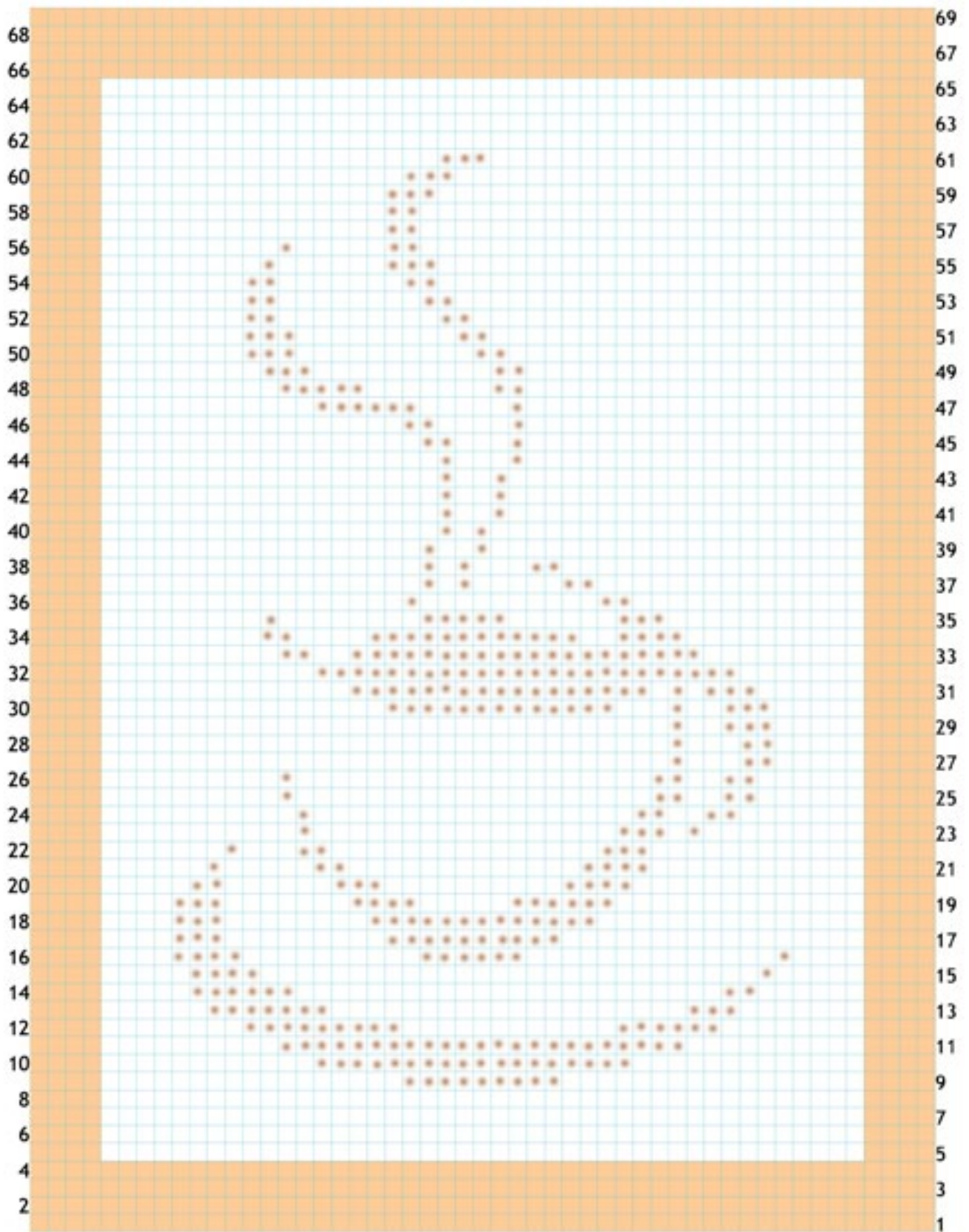
FINISHED SIZE: 12 x 12 inches

- Seed Stitch, beginning with knit
- Odd Rows: Knit; Even Rows, Purl
- Odd Rows: Purl; Even Rows, Knit
