## Touch-A, Touch-A, Touch-A Touch Me Afghan

Soft and luxurious, this afghan is a very simple construction: all front loop half double crochets. I was asked to write up this pattern for the local yarn representative, who sell's the yarn, which will be available for purchase in the store where I work as a crochet instructor.

**FINISHED SIZE:** 50 x 76 inches

### MATERIALS

- 40 skeins: Muench Touch Me (Fiber Content: 72% Rayon Microfiber/28% Wool; Yardage: about 61 yards/50 grams; Yarn Color: 3650?; Yarn Weight: 4)
- Hook: US G/6 - 4.0 mm
- Tapestry Needle
- Snippers

**LEGEND:** CH = Chain      HDC = Half Double Crochet

### INSTRUCTIONS

Foundation Row: Ch 225 + 2 (counts as HDC throughout pattern)

Row 1: Hdc front loop of fourth ch from hook and across, making sure to hdc in top ch of turning ch 2 (225 hdc). Ch 2, turn.

Row 2: Hdc in front loop of second hdc and across, making sure to hdc in top ch of turning ch 2. (225 hdc). Ch 2, turn.

Repeat Row 2 for 163 more rows. Fasten off. Sew in ends, if you have not already crocheted them in.
