

A Hooker's World

The name – *Kid*, a song by The Pretenders – was inspired by the yarn name (Euro Baby Kids Rock) and for whom the afghan would be most appropriate.

FINISHED SIZE: 36 x 36 inches

MATERIALS

- 902-984 yards worsted weight yarn
- US J Hook



LEGEND

CH/CHs: Chain/Chains

DC: Double Crochet

FPDD: Front Post Double Crochet: YO, Insert hook from front to back around post of stitch indicated. YO and pull up aloop (3 loops on hook). (YO and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

SC: Single Crochet

YO: Yarn Over

INSTRUCTIONS

Chain 99.

Row 1: 5 DC in sixth CH from hook (5 skipped CHs count as first DC and 2 skipped CHs), skip next 2 CHs, DC in next CH, *skip next 2 CHs, 5 DC in next CH, skip next 2 CHs, DC in next CH; repeat from * across.

Row 2: CH 3 (counts as first DC, now and throughout), turn; 2 DC in first DC, skip next 2 DC. Work FPDC around next DC, * skip next 2 DC, 5 DC in next DC, skip next 2 DC, work FPDC around next DC; repeat from * across to last 3 DC, skip next 2 DC, 3 DC in last DC.

Repeat pattern (Rows 1 & 2) for total of 42 rows.

Border

Row 1: DC

Row 2: SC in each DC; three SC in each corner DC

Row 3: Alternate 2 DC in front loop/2 DC in back loop of each DC.
